General Guidelines

The **AMERICANA E-journal of American Studies in Hungary** is a peer-reviewed, entirely non-profit journal maintained by the Department of American Studies at the Institute of English and American Studies, University of Szeged, Hungary and is licensed under <u>Creative Commons 4.0</u>.

The journal serves exclusively as an educational and academic forum for scholars and students having interest in the field of American studies. The scope of the journal includes various aspects of the study of the culture of the United States of America and the Americas, with a special interest in research carried out in Hungary.

AMERICANA is indexed by the following professional organizations: DOAJ, EBSCO, MLA.

Regarding the publications of reviews specifically, scholarly books published in English or in Hungarian within or outside of Hungary in the field of American Studies will be considered. Only reviews on books published within two years will be considered.

Your review should introduce the contents of the reviewed book as well as the general area of academic research the book addresses.

If you wish to write a review for **AMERICANA**, please contact the review editors.

Submission Guidelines

Style:

- Send your review in Microsoft Office Word (.doc or .docx) format
- Attach a separate, high resolution image of the cover of the reviewed book in .jpg format
- Use Times New Roman, 12 point font for the body of the text
- The text should be single-spaced, with alignment set justified, without indenting the first lines of the paragraphs, and with an empty line between paragraphs
- Since AMERICANA is an online journal, you are welcomed to include hyperlinks in your review
- Use parenthetical references (Author page) and, if possible, avoid footnotes
- If necessary, include a "Works cited" section listing the material you referred to in your review. The format of a book reference should be: Family Name, First Name. Date of publication. *The Title of the Book*. Place of publication: Publisher.

Form:

- The title of your document should be "your last name_review" (e.g. Smith_review)
- Begin with the title of your review
- Provide a short biographical note about yourself of about 50-100 words. Start with your
 position and academic affiliation and include your research interests and most recent or
 most relevant publications. Please provide your e-mail address at the end of your bio.
- Give the publication details of the reviewed book in the following way:

Reviews should be approximately 1500 words long

Process of publication

- Send the review editors the publication details of the book you propose to review.
- If the review editors deem that the book you wish to review is within the scope of the journal, they will send you a copy of the Book Review Submission Guidelines and propose a deadline for completion.
- After the review editors have received your completed review, they will e-mail you their and the language editor's comments and suggestions. You will then be asked to consider their remarks, revise, and resubmit your review.
- The final step before publication is to check the text of your review online using the hidden link the general editor sends you. At this point, you can still make minor changes to your text, such as correcting typos. If you confirm that the text is in the state you re-sent it after the revision, the link will soon be made public, and your review will appear in the contents of the particular Volume and Number along with the other publications.
